Stepping Stones provides a holistic approach with the people who know them best, promoting positive outcomes.



Offering a wide variety of appropriate play based, planned activities to support your child's learning and development. It also offers the opportunity to meet other children known to Portage who have a similar learning profile, as well as their families.



Stepping Stones is run by Portage Home Visitors and is accessible to any family with children that have been referred to Portage, Speech and Language or Talking Together but do not meet criteria.



The aim of Stepping Stones is to enhance and facilitate Children's early Social, communication and language experiences. We focus on increasing opportunities and playful interactions between Children, their Parents/ Carers and practitioners.



Parents and children can access fun experiences through play. Offering exciting activities role modelled by skilled and experienced staff.



Children are able to access the outdoor area each session, which is perfect for developing gross and fine motor skills! With access to a sensory room to explore lights and sounds.

Stepping Stones operates at Wheatley Family hub every two weeks: 10am until 11:30am. Dates will be confirmed at the start of each term and given to families accessing the group.
