Thank you for your request for information dated 22 July 2024, regarding empty properties.

Please find below City of Doncaster Council's response to the questions you have raised.

Request:

"I am writing to ask you to supply details of The address (including street number and postcode) of homes that

- a) have been empty for over 12 months
- b) have been empty for under 12 months

I would like to invest into the restoration of these empty and/or derelict properties."

Response:

This information is exempt from disclosure under Section 'a031(1)(a) of the Freedom of information Act. Section 31 exempts information from the 'a0right of access under the Freedom of Information Act if disclosure would prejudice the prevention or detection of crime.

We consider that the disclosure of the information would be likely to 'a0prejudice the prevention of crime, as it is believed that if a list of empty properties and addresses were to be disclosed, then these properties would become more 'a0vulnerable to squatting, associated crime and other forms of criminal 'a0activity including, but not limited to criminal damage, extraction of 'a0electricity and the stripping of empty properties. This would increase the 'a0social and economic costs in these areas as a result.

As Section 31 is a qualified exemption, City of Doncaster Council is obliged to consider 'a0whether disclosure of the information would be in the public interest 'a0before refusing to supply the information. 'a0Therefore the City of Doncaster Council has taken 'a0the following factors into account:

Factors for disclosing information:

• To release the information would be in the spirit of openness 'a0and transparency. The information is of interest to some members of the public.

Factors for withholding information:

- There is a strong public interest in avoiding the likely 'a0prejudice to the prevention of crime.

 Tackling crime 'a0involves a significant strain on public expense and it is in the public 'a0interest to ensure that public resources are used cost-effectively.
- The information would contribute to criminal knowledge.
- The public interest in avoiding damage to property.

- The efficient use of public and police resources.
- The potential for indirect consequences of crime, for example 'a0the impact on neighbouring properties of crimes perpetrated on the empty 'a0properties.
- There has been a recent increase in empty properties in the area 'a0being targeted by criminal
 activity and releasing details of empty 'a0properties could have a detrimental effect on steps being
 taken to prevent this.

Taking these factors into consideration, the City of Doncaster Council has decided that the 'a0reasons for withholding the information outweigh those for disclosing it 'a0and we will not be providing the information at this time.

City of Doncaster Council estimates that it has cost £49.00 to respond to this request for information.
