

## STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposals are intended to remove an existing restriction which is effectively redundant as, the section of carriageway in question is a dead end, so through traffic is not an issue and the current restriction is "except for access", thereby allowing vehicular access for deliveries / collections etc. The proposal should neither compromise road safety, visibility, nor the free flow of traffic.
