

**CITY OF DONCASTER COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, DONCASTER)
(PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018
(AMENDMENT NO. 89) ORDER 2025**

The City of Doncaster Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1 The City of Doncaster Council (Various Roads, Doncaster) (Parking, Stopping, Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2018 shall have the effect as though the following items were included in Schedule 1.03 No waiting at any time:-

- i) Amersall Road, Scawthorpe

West side

From its junction with the southern kerbline of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

- ii) Amersall Road, Scawthorpe

East side

From its junction with the southern kerbline of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 12 metres in a southerly direction.

- iii) Castle Hills Road, Scawthorpe

West side

From its junction with the northern kerbline of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

- iv) Castle Hills Road, Scawthorpe

East side

From its junction with the northern kerbline of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

- v) Jossey Lane, Scawthorpe

South side

From a point 14 metres west of the western kerbline of Amersall Road, for a distance of 33 metres in a generally easterly direction.

vi) Jossey Lane, Scawthorpe

North side

From a point 12 metres west of the western kerbline of Castle Hills Road, for a distance of 34 metres in a generally easterly direction.

vii) Danesway, Scawthorpe

West side

From its junction with the northern kerbline of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

viii) Danesway, Scawthorpe

East side

From its junction with the northern kerbline of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

ix) Jossey Lane, Scawthorpe

North side

From a point 10 metres west of the western kerbline of Danesway, for a distance of 25 metres in a generally easterly direction.

2 This Order shall come into operation on the 10th day of February 2025 and may be cited as the "City of Doncaster Council (Various Roads, Doncaster) (Parking, Stopping, Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2018 (Amendment No.89) Order 2025".

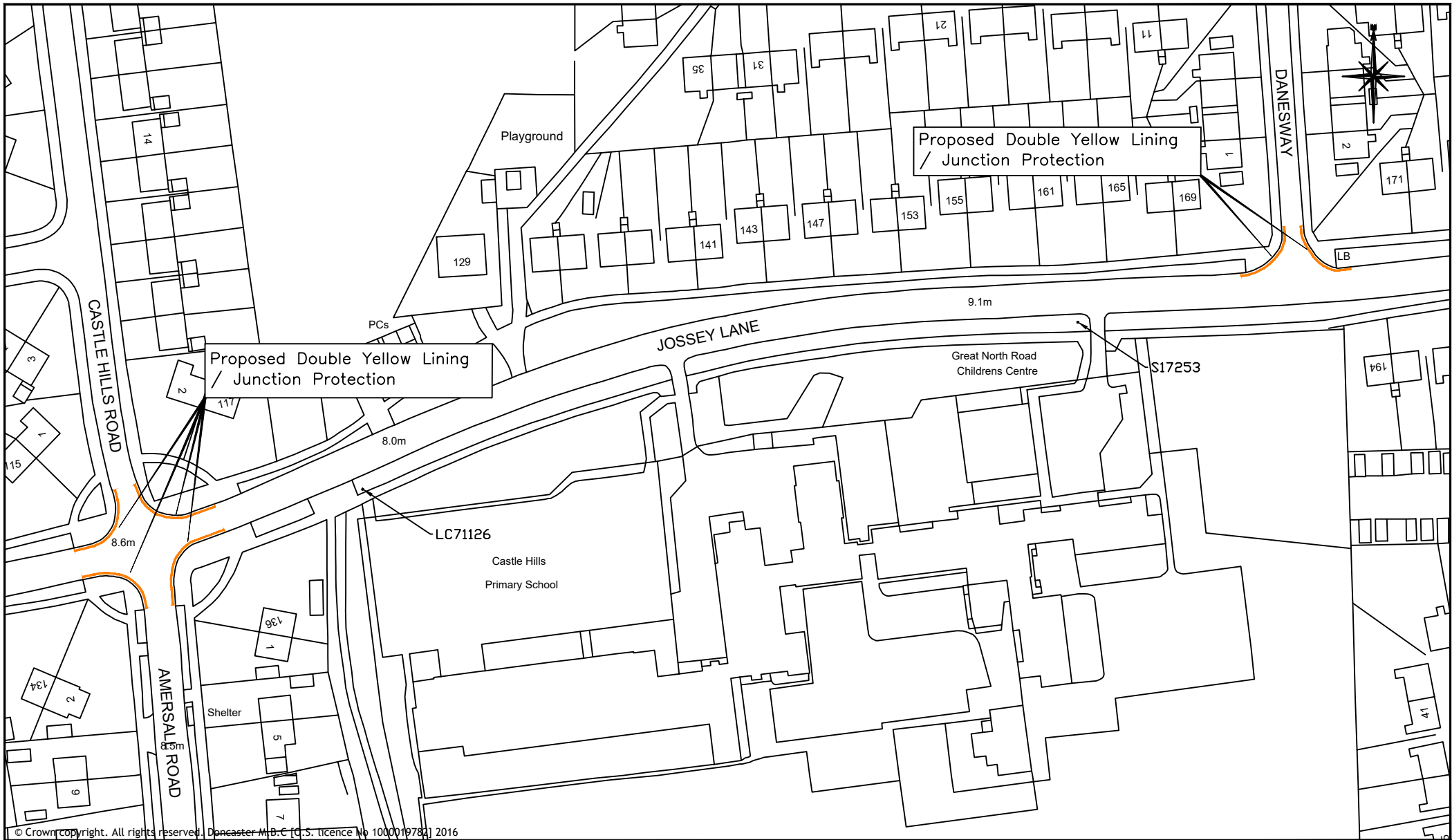

Notice is hereby given that on the 22nd day of January 2025 the City of Doncaster Council made an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The effect of the Order that will come into operation on the 10th day of February 2025 will be to introduce a No waiting at any time restriction on the following lengths of road:-

i) Amersall Road, Scawthorpe

West side

From its junction with the southern kerblines of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

ii) Amersall Road, Scawthorpe

East side

From its junction with the southern kerblines of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 12 metres in a southerly direction.

iii) Castle Hills Road, Scawthorpe

West side

From its junction with the northern kerblines of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

iv) Castle Hills Road, Scawthorpe

East side

From its junction with the northern kerblines of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

v) Jossey Lane, Scawthorpe

South side

From a point 14 metres west of the western kerblines of Amersall Road, for a distance of 33 metres in a generally easterly direction.

vi) Jossey Lane, Scawthorpe

North side

From a point 12 metres west of the western kerblines of Castle Hills Road, for a distance of 34 metres in a generally easterly direction.

vii) Danesway, Scawthorpe

West side

From its junction with the northern kerblines of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

viii) Danesway, Scawthorpe

East side

From its junction with the northern kerbline of Jossey Lane, for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

ix) Jossey Lane, Scawthorpe

North side

From a point 10 metres west of the western kerbline of Danesway, for a distance of 25 metres in a generally easterly direction

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, for the collection and delivery of postal packets or if it is a vehicle being operated by or on behalf of the South Yorkshire Safety Camera Partnerships while carrying out roadside monitoring or enforcement operations. The usual exceptions for disabled persons vehicles are also included in the Order

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restricted roads may be examined at the Council Offices, Civic Office, Waterdale, Doncaster between 8.45 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. Monday to Friday or on the City of Doncaster Council Website via the following link <https://www.doncaster.gov.uk/services/transport-streets-parking/made-orders>

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within six weeks from the 22nd day of January 2025 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
