From a point 37 metres northwest of its junction with St. Catherine's Avenue for a distance of 97 metres in a north westerly direction

This Order shall come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April 2025 and may be cited as the "City of Doncaster Council (Various Roads, Doncaster) (Moving Traffic) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Amendment No.31) Order 2025".


